4x4 Gauze Pads

To be used for wound dressing, cleaning, prepping, or packing.



Tweezers

To safely remove foreign objects beneath the skin, avoiding contact with your own skin.



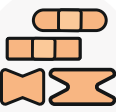
8x10 Gauze Pads

To be used when high-absorbency is needed for heavy draining wounds.



Medical Adhesive Tape

To attach bandages or gauze to the skin around wounds.



Adhesive Band-Aids

M, S, Butterfly, and H variants.



Latex Gloves

For your protection.



Gauze Roller Bandage

To support bleeding wounds and injured limbs or joints by maintaining pressure.



CPR Pocket Mask

To prevent the transfer of body fluids from mouth to mouth resuscitation.



Triangle Bandage

Use as a large dressing, a sling to support a limb, or to secure a dressing in place.



Elastic Crepe Wraps

Supports sprains and strains. Secures wound dressing.



Antiseptic Cleaning Wipes

To disinfect minor cuts and scrapes.



Splint

Use to stabilize suspected arm or leg fracture. Supports both ends of the fracture site.



Emergency Blanket

Use to treat shock or hypothermia by retaining body warmth and preventing heat loss.
